CAST N' BLAST PACKING LIST

Clothing:

- Orange hat/vest/clothing for safety
- Short-sleeve shirts
- Long-sleeve lightweight shirt for sun protection
- Quick dry shorts
- Swimming wear
- Socks
- Personal Undergarments
- Lightweight pants
- Warm gortex/waterproof jacket and pants or good quality rain jacket and pants
- 2-3 warm tops (fleece or wool)
- 2-3 pair pants (jeans, fleece, carhartts for in camp)
- 1-2 sets long underwear (quick-dry fabrics)
- 2-3 pairs wool or synthetic socks
- Hat for sun protection
- Non-cotton winter hat and gloves
- Sturdy sandals with heel strap or water shoes
- Walking shoes for in camp and short hikes

Personal Items:

- Water bottle
- Flashlight or headlamp*
- Camera (waterproof or in a waterproof case)*
- Several Ziploc type bags for personal items
- Sunglasses with retainer strap
- Plenty of waterproof sunscreen
- Lip balm/chapstick
- Small towel
- Biodegradable camp soap
- Moisturizing lotion
- Backup glasses/contacts
- Personal toiletry items & medicines
- Good book*

* Dry bags are not guaranteed to keep dry. Please put anything that could be damaged by water in waterproof cases or bags inside of our dry bags. Ziploc bags are recommended for books, playing cards, etc.

** If you are planning on fishing, you will need an Idaho and/or Oregon fishing license.

*** We will supply rods and tackle if you let us know you're planning on fishing. Feel free to bring your own if you'd like.

**** We include a bottle of red & white table wine at dinner and a selection of local beers. If you would like something specific, feel free to bring it and we will safely pack it up for you.
